

## **NATIONAL NYCDA MALE AND FEMALE SENIOR & TEEN OUTSTANDING DANCER SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS**

All Regional **Senior** and **Teen** Outstanding Dancer Scholarship Winners and Runners-up are equally eligible for National NYCDA Outstanding Dancer Scholarship Awards.

### **NATIONAL NYCDA MALE AND FEMALE SENIOR OUTSTANDING DANCER SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS**

NYCDA National Senior Outstanding Dancers: \$1000 each.  
NYCDA National 1<sup>st</sup> Runners-up Senior Outstanding Dancer: \$500 each.  
NYCDA National 2<sup>nd</sup> Runners-up Senior Outstanding Dancer: \$300 each.

National NYCDA Senior Outstanding Dancer Scholarship winners will each be awarded a lifetime NYCDA Convention Scholarship, and a one-year scholarship to both Steps on Broadway and Peridance in NYC.

All six Senior Finalists (3 male and 3 female) will be awarded class scholarships to Broadway Dance Center in NYC.

### **NATIONAL NYCDA MALE AND FEMALE TEEN OUTSTANDING DANCER SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS**

NYCDA National Teen Outstanding Dancers: \$750 each.  
NYCDA National 1<sup>st</sup> Runners-up Teen Outstanding Dancer: \$350 each.  
NYCDA National 2<sup>nd</sup> Runners-up Teen Outstanding Dancer: \$200 each.

National NYCDA Teen Outstanding Dancer Scholarship winners will each be awarded a 2017-2018 NYCDA Convention Scholarship, and a one-year scholarship to both Steps on Broadway and Peridance in NYC.

All six Teen Finalists (3 male and 3 female) will be awarded class scholarships to Broadway Dance Center in NYC.

### **REGISTRATION:**

- All participating dancers must be registered for the entire National Season Finale! Workshop and pre-registered for the National NYCDA Outstanding Dancer Scholarship Audition. Dancers auditioning for the Senior Scholarship must be registered for the Senior Workshop. Dancers auditioning for the Teen Scholarship must be registered for the Teen Workshop.
- National Season Finale! Workshop Registration is complimentary to all Regional Outstanding Award winners and runners-up.
- Reply forms and Registration forms (received in this packet) must be returned by May 5, 2017 with your studio's Outstanding Dancer Summary form (will be emailed to Studio Contact). Note: Forms received past this deadline forfeit the guarantee of special outstanding dancer gifts received at the National Season Finale!
- Registration fee for the National Outstanding Dancer Scholarship Audition is \$250/Seniors and \$250/Teens, which includes the Solo Adjudication and dancer's Closing Gala ticket. Registration forms **must** be submitted with your **school's Workshop Registration** by May 5, 2017. Early registration is encouraged.

### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

- All Regional winners of the NYCDA Outstanding Dancer Award and their runners-up are eligible for the National NYCDA Outstanding Dancer Award.
- Dancers will be assigned numbers and attendance will be monitored in ALL classes during the National Season Finale! Workshop, including special jazz and ballet Outstanding Dancer audition classes.
- Attendance is mandatory for ALL Scholarship Adjudication Classes and Opening Number rehearsals for Seniors and Teens. Rehearsal schedule is subject to change at any point during the convention, as per NYCDA.
- All participating dancers must be prepared with a solo (3 minute maximum) which will be performed at the Outstanding Dancer Solo Adjudication, which could begin as early as Thursday evening June 29<sup>th</sup>. Seniors and Teens may not compete in the National Finals with the same solo.
- Teen and Senior Dancers must plan to arrive to the Sheraton NY on Thur. June 29<sup>th</sup> by 11 am for mandatory Orientation Meetings and choreography rehearsal for the Opening Number of the Closing Night Gala. (check-in 9 am)
- Dancers will also participate in a Final Audition consisting of a short ballet and jazz combination (similar to the Regional audition). No observers will be permitted.
- Faculty judges will select six Senior and six Teen finalists (3 male and 3 female).
- The finalists will each perform their prepared solos at the Closing Night Gala for a panel of judges consisting of NYCDA faculty and other show business professionals.

**Finalists are determined by:** 40% Outstanding Dancer Solo Adjudication 60% Workshop/Final Audition Evaluation  
**Winners are determined by:** 60% Workshop/Final Audition Evaluation 40% Gala Solo Performance



## **NATIONAL NYCDA MALE AND FEMALE JUNIOR & MINI OUTSTANDING DANCER SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS**

All Regional **Junior** and **Mini** Outstanding Dancer Scholarship Winners and Runners-up are equally eligible for National NYCDA Outstanding Dancer Scholarship Awards.

### **NATIONAL NYCDA MALE AND FEMALE JUNIOR OUTSTANDING DANCER SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS**

NYCDA National Junior Outstanding Dancers: \$500 each.  
NYCDA National 1<sup>st</sup> Runners-up Junior Outstanding Dancer: \$250 each.  
NYCDA National 2<sup>nd</sup> Runners-up Junior Outstanding Dancer: \$125 each.

National NYCDA Junior Outstanding Dancer Scholarship winners will each be awarded a 2017-2018 NYCDA Convention Scholarship.

#### **REGISTRATION:**

- All participating dancers must be registered for the entire National Season Finale! Workshop and pre-register for the National NYCDA Outstanding Dancer Scholarship Audition. Dancers auditioning for the Junior Scholarship must be registered for the Junior Workshop. Dancers auditioning for the Mini Scholarship must be registered for the Mini Workshop.
- National Season Finale! Workshop Registration is complimentary to all Regional winners and runners-up.
- Reply forms and Registration forms (received in this packet) must be returned by May 5, 2017 with your studio's Outstanding Dancer Summary form (will be emailed to Studio Contact). Note: Forms received past this deadline forfeit the guarantee of special outstanding dancer gifts received at the National Season Finale!
- Registration fee for the National Outstanding Dancer Scholarship Audition is \$225/Juniors and \$225/Minis, which includes the Solo Adjudication and dancer's Junior Gala ticket. Registration forms **must** be submitted with your **school's Workshop Registration** by May 5, 2017. Early registration is encouraged.

#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

- All Regional winners of the NYCDA Outstanding Dancer Award and their runners-up are eligible for the National NYCDA Outstanding Dancer Award.
- Dancers will be assigned numbers and attendance will be monitored in ALL classes during the National Season Finale! Workshop, including any special Outstanding Dancer audition classes.
- Attendance is mandatory for ALL Scholarship Adjudication Classes and Opening Number rehearsals for Juniors and Minis. Rehearsal schedule is subject to change at any point during the convention, as per NYCDA.
- All participating dancers must be prepared with a solo (3 minute maximum) which will be performed at the Outstanding Dancer Solo Adjudication, which could begin as early as Friday June 30<sup>th</sup>, in the afternoon.
- Jr and Mini Dancers must plan to arrive to the Sheraton NY on Thursday June 29<sup>th</sup> by 7 pm (check-in at 5 pm) for a mandatory Orientation Meeting and choreography rehearsals for the opening number of the Junior Gala.
- Dancers will participate in a Final Audition consisting of a short ballet and jazz combination (similar to a regional audition). No observers will be permitted.
- Faculty judges will select six Junior and six Mini finalists (3 male and 3 female).
- The finalists will each perform their prepared solos at the Junior Gala for a panel of judges consisting of NYCDA faculty and other show business professionals.

**Finalists are determined by:** 40% Outstanding Dancer Solo Adjudication 60% Workshop/Final Audition Evaluation  
**Winners are determined by:** 60% Workshop/Final Audition Evaluation 40% Gala Solo Performance
